The meeting was relatively brief, and focused primarily on a presentation from the County's Class and Comp division regarding information we had requested on compensation comparisons. This was information we had requested to assist us in developing counter proposals regarding compensation. While there was nothing earth shattering in the material, it will be useful to us as we prepare for our next bargaining session on April 4th.
